



OHS Status Report

February is upon us, and the high school is gearing up for a strong finish for the class of 2020 and looking ahead towards the 2020-2021 school year. With the second semester in full swing, the seniors only have three and a half months to go for completion of their twelve-year journey. This is an exciting, but stressful time for everyone involved. Parents and students are coming to the conclusion that they are within sight of this major accomplishment, and the high school staff is engaged in trying to keep all the arrow pointing in the same direction. Graduation is at 1:00 pm June 6th in the Omak High School Gym.

In preparation for the 2020-2021 school year, the high school counseling team is preparing for the student registration and master schedule building process. The opportunity to showcase the electives on January 24th seemed to be a big hit with staff and students and will be the start of this endeavor. The next steps will be class meetings to outline what each grade band will focus on for their next year's schedule. These meetings occur in early March. The students will then select their courses of desire in the middle of March, with the objective of having all the data into Skyward no later than April 1st. This gives parents one last look during our Student Led Conferences, to confirm the class choices to be in line with the High School and Beyond Plan. Just after Spring Break, the scheduling team will then generate the master schedule based on the least amount of conflicts for our students. This is an exciting, but stressful time as our graduating class is expected to be near 80, but the incoming class of 9th graders will be close to 140!

In February, the middle school and high school staff came together on the Learning Improvement Day (February 14th), to look at brining Character Strong to our district. As our combined staff believe that we need a Social and Emotional Learning program to supplement the hard work our staff is doing with academics, it is



critical to have all the stakeholders on the same page. As the school year comes to a close, our buildings will determine what platform may work best to impact students. More information to come.

Just a quick note that Omak High School will be participating in Washington Junior Business Week once again. This tradition spans nearly seventeen year long and has

survived when other programs around the state have given up on this amazing opportunity. The 2020 Okanogan/Omak Junior Business Week will be March 16-20 and held at the Okanogan County Agri-Plex.
